**Rosa agrestis, 1990-2023, at least 6 fig grid ref**

**Best to Search: mid August - September**

Yellow highlighting is for sites I favour visiting first

Woolton Hill, NE of	SU45426303	24-May-19	Roadside hedge. Seems to be this but ought to be confirmed when in fruit. [Confirmed on a return visit on 4 Jul 2019. The bush is regularly flailed so the form is not standard, the main stem looks surprisingly old.]
Micheldever Station, NE of	SU53004483	08-May-18	A single v. small flailed bush with no hips at SU 53007 44834. Showed distinctive cuneate leaflets with extensive sweet scented glandular hairs. Bush cannot be confirmed as no other distinctive features were present (ie hips).
Mill Farm, Isington	SU772422	25-Jul-17	Duplicate specimen expertly confirmed Sep 2017. At SU7729 4227 in hedgerow, beside footpath/track, near to a gate.
Noar Hill	SU742318	01-Sep-94	It persisted at least until 1994 at one locality at c.SU7425 3188 on Top Bank. Note that a incorrect (site centroid) map reference of SU741318 for this record has also been entered into Mapmate. Searched for unsuccessfully on 12 Sep 2007.

I have omitted Porton Down as access permission is difficult to obtain.

Worth searching Noar Hill again for it.
